ECO FRIENDLY POLICY

At Lantallack, we care deeply about the environment and about preserving the beautiful surroundings in which we live so that they can be enjoyed by future generations and our guests. For this reason we are committed to the following:-

- We comply with the requirements of environmental legislation and approved codes of practice.
- Lantallack is a member of Coast Cornwall Sustainable Tourism Project.
- We support local food producers, restaurants, pubs and tourist attractions, along with shops and transport. We believe in buying locally wherever possible to reduce packaging and road mileage, and if not available, we support Fair Trade products.
- We use scrap paper for note paper and re-use old envelopes.
- We reduce, re-use and recycle as much as possible.
- We re-use bags when shopping and encourage our self-catering guests to do the same.
- Lantallack has a strict no smoking policy.
- All bedrooms have energy saving light bulbs and individually controlled radiators to conserve energy.
- We use eco-friendly cleaning products and minimise the number of towels washed by asking our guests to re-use.
- We encourage guests to explore the local area rather than travelling further away.
- A farmers market is held at Trerulefoot (approx. 1 mile away) once a month.
- We produce delicious organic apple juice from our own orchard, blended from many different varieties of Cornish apples including 'Tommy Knight', 'Venus Pippin', 'Manaccan Primrose' and 'The Rattler', to name but a few.
- Polly's Bower and Pippin Cottage have been converted to a very high standard using locally sourced materials, sustainable wood, slates and contractors. Windows are double-glazed and chemical-free paint used through-out. All wood for the log burner comes from the estate and we use low-energy light bulbs and fair trade, eco-friendly products in all our properties. Our policy is to recycle everything we possibly can.
- Where possible, particularly during weddings, we encourage car sharing between guests coming from the same area.
